Practical Relevance at its best

Lecturers at MBS bring real-world business experience into the classroom. We emphasize teaching by experts with practical corporate experience, ensuring students learn current and relevant content. Students can also undertake internships during their studies, applying theoretical knowledge, gaining insights into the German and international economy, and starting to build their professional networks.

Our alumni work at e.g. EY, BMW, Amazon, Sony, small and medium sized enterprises, family firms or their own successful start-up. After graduation from a German university, students may stay in Germany for 18 month to find a suitable job and to apply for the EU Blue Card: bluecard-eu.de

According to the Stepstone Salary Survey (2019), Business Administration graduates in Germany earn an average of EUR 43,189. Master's graduates earn 14% more than bachelor's graduates on average. Managers in Business Administration earn an average of EUR 74,100. Salaries vary based on position, specialization, industry, company size, location, and individual qualifications and experience.

WHY GERMANY?

Germany is the **economic and technological powerhouse** of the European Union, and Munich is its business hotspot #1.

Whether it is cars or education, people all around the world recognize "Made in Germany" as a seal of quality. A German university degree is highly respected by employers worldwide.

Germany is a safe country, and Munich is its safest bigger city – also on an international scale. In town or in the countryside, by day or by night you can move freely here without having to take any special precautions.

English is the dominant second language and it is easy for foreigners to communicate.

As a non-EU citizen, **you can stay in Germany** for another 18 months after graduation to find a job. You will be eligible for a permanent residency permit after working here for just two years.

STUDY ABROAD

The semester abroad at one of MBS's over 70 partner universities worldwide is an integral part of the Bachelor International Business and the Master International Business. In the other master's programs, the semester abroad is optional. However, master's students have the opportunity to earn a dual degree (MSc or MBA) from the partner university during an extended study abroad period of two semesters instead of one.

During the MBA program, an International Week takes place at one of our partner universities of the "EMBA Consortium for Global Business Innovation" – its members are leading business schools worldwide.


